For Its Ecotourism

Ecotourism has some devoted champions in Honduras, providers who seek to protect the land by responsibly showcasing its natural riches. A great example of this approach to tourism is the **Lodge at Pico Bonito**, located in the country's northwestern state of La Ceiba. The luxury lodge's setting at the base of the Pico Bonito National Park lends to a feeling of serenity while also providing easy access to exciting outdoor adventures throughout the park's mountains, rivers, and waterfalls.

Home to more than 420 bird species throughout its 400 acres, the lodge's mainstay is birding. The lodge has five multilingual birding guides and a head naturalist on staff; this group of shepherds helps oversee the conservation of the adjoining national park's resources.
